**Re: Installing HAWK signal at the intersection of Florida Avenue and 11th Street, NE
Notice 13-47-TOA**

Dear Ms. Laskaris,

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following modification in your jurisdiction.

During an April 22nd, 2013 community meeting at the New Samaritan Baptist Church, residents and Advisory Neighborhood Committee (ANC) members for 6A01 and 5D06 requested that DDOT install a HAWK pedestrian signal at the intersection of Florida Avenue and 11th Street, NE. An independent determination conducted by the DDOT's Transportation Operations Administration (TOA) shows that the intersection meets standard MUTCD (Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices) warrants as prescribed by the Federal Highway Administration for the installation of a HAWK signal. Therefore in the interest of pedestrian crossing and vehicle safety, DDOT's Transportation Operations Administration (TOA) has determined to install the HAWK signal at this location.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing, not later than thirty days (30), excluding weekends and holidays, after the date of this notice, with the District Department of Transportation, Transportation Operations Administration, 55 M Street, SE, 4th Floor, Washington, DC 20003
