**Re: Restrict westbound left-turns at the intersection of Florida Avenue and 11<sup>th</sup> Street, NE  
Notice 13-49-TOA**


Dear Mr. Holmes,

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following modification in your jurisdiction.

Currently, at the intersection of Florida Avenue and 11<sup>th</sup> Street, NE, motorists are allowed to make westbound left-turns from Florida Avenue to 11<sup>th</sup> Street. However, during an April 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2013 community meeting at the New Samaritan Baptist Church, residents and the Advisory Neighborhood Committee (ANC) members for 6A01 and 5D06 requested that DDOT restrict the westbound left-turn movement at this intersection. Therefore in the interest of pedestrian and vehicle safety, DDOT's Transportation Operations Administration (TOA) has made an independent determination to restrict the westbound left-turn movement, from Florida Avenue to 11<sup>th</sup> Street, at this intersection.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing, not later than thirty days (30), excluding weekends and holidays, after the date of this notice, with the District Department of Transportation, Transportation Operations Administration, 55 M Street, SE, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Washington, DC 20003
