**Re: Installation of all-way stop control at the intersection of 15th & Girard Streets NE
NOI #19-33-TOA**

Dear Chairperson Higgins:

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent (NOI) to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following modifications in your jurisdiction.

- **Install all-way stop control at the intersection of 15th & Girard Streets NE**

At the conclusion of the study at the subject intersection, DDOT determined that a stop signs should be installed on the Girard Street NE approaches to 15th Street NE. Currently, 15th Street, which serves north and southbound directions, is required to stop at Girard Street. Under this Notice of Intent, DDOT will require the Girard Street approaches to also stop at the intersection. This action will require all approaches to the intersection to stop.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing by March 27, 2019 (thirty business days after the date of this notice), with the District Department of Transportation, Transportation Operations Administration at 55 M Street, SE, Washington, D.C. 20003.
