**Re: Installation of school pick up and drop off parking signs
NOI #14-33-TOA**

Dear Chairperson Hart:

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction.

- ***Installation of school pick up and drop off parking signs***

The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) received a request from Oyster Adams Bilingual School at 2020 19th ST, NW to designate the spaces in front of the school to student pick-up and drop off parking during school hours. Currently the parking restrictions at those spaces are "No Parking 8AM-9AM and 2:45PM-3:45PM, Mon-Fri". DCMR Title 24 section 6.2 gives DDOT authority to place signs prohibiting parking on streets adjacent to any school on school days. Therefore, our office will change signs to designate those spaces to student pick-up and drop off parking. The new signs will read "**School Loading Zone Driver must Remain in Vehicle No Parking 8AM-4PM School Days**"

All comments on this subject matter must be sent to Mr. James Cheeks of the District Department of Transportation at 55 M ST, SE, 6th Floor, Washington, D.C. no later than thirty days (30) after the date of this notice.
