**Re: Installation of "No Standing or Parking Anytime" Signs
Notice 13-66-TOA
24th Street and Benning Road, NE**

Dear Ms. Muhammad,

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to each of the affected ANCs and the City Council Secretary for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction:


- Installation of "No Standing or Parking Anytime" Signs

Currently, the signalized intersection of 24th Street and Benning Road, NE does not have parking restriction signs on either side of 24th Street leading up to Benning Road. A recent on-site visit revealed that the lack of restriction signs allows vehicles to park on both sides of the street on top of the loop detectors that control the signal at the intersection. This causes the signal at this location to unnecessarily give green time to 24th Street. Therefore, in the interest of pedestrian and vehicle safety, an independent determination has been made by DDOT's Transportation Operations Administration (TOA) to install "No Standing or Parking Anytime" signs on both sides of the street approximately 60' from the intersection to improve traffic operations at this location.
