**Re: Installation of school pick up and drop off parking signs

Dear Chairperson Solomon:

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction.

- ***Installation of school pick up and drop off parking signs***

The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) received a request from the Hardy Middle School at 1819 35th ST, NW, to extend the No Parking School Days area in front of the school on east side of 35th street. Currently the 40 feet long space requested, even though in front of school, it is zoned for Residential Parking Permit holders (RPP). DCMR Title 24 section 6.2 gives DDOT authority to place signs prohibiting parking on streets adjacent to any school on school days. Therefore, our office will change signs to add 40 feet extension to existing "No Parking School Days" area.

All comments on this subject matter must be sent to Mr. James Cheeks of the District Department of Transportation at 55 M ST, SE, 6th Floor, Washington, D.C. no later than thirty days (30) after the date of this notice.
