**Re: Converting one-way traffic operation to two-way traffic operation on 35th Street between Wisconsin Avenue and Whitehaven Pkwy, NW
Notice 13-50-TOA**

Dear Ms. Smith,

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following modification in your jurisdiction.

Currently motorists are allowed to travel one-way in the southbound direction only on 35th Street between Wisconsin Avenue and Whitehaven Pkwy, NW. However, the District Department of Transportation has received requests from neighborhood residents to convert the existing one-way traffic operation (southbound direction only) on 35th Street to two-way traffic operation. Therefore, in the interest of public safety, an independent determination has been made by the DDOT's Transportation Operations Administration (TOA) to convert the existing one-way traffic operation to two-way traffic operations on 35th Street between Wisconsin Avenue and Whitehaven Pkwy, NW.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing, not later than thirty days (30), excluding weekends and holidays, after the date of this notice, with the District Department of Transportation, Transportation Operations Administration, 55 M Street, SE, 4th Floor, Washington, DC 20003
