Dear Mrs. Smith,

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) hereby gives the Council of the District of Columbia written notice of its intent to modify traffic requirements.

Currently, the cross-type intersection of 3rd Street and I Street, S.E., is controlled by a stop operation for I Street, N.W., so as to stop at 3rd Street. The area residents and Advisory Neighborhood Commission 6 D have requested that DDOT install a multi-way stop at this intersection. However, a recent field observation has revealed that the current control for this intersection is no longer adequate.

Therefore, in the interest of pedestrian and vehicle safety, an independent determination has been made by the DDOT/Transportation Operations Administration to install a multi-way stop control for 3rd Street and I Street, so as to stop at both streets.
