Notice 11-34-TS

Dear Ms. Smith,

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) hereby gives the Council of the District of Columbia written notice of its intent to modify traffic requirements.

Currently, the four way intersection of 42nd Street and Military Road, N.W., is controlled by stop controls so as to require 42nd Street to stop at Military Road, N.W. In addition, northbound traffic on 42nd Street is restricted to right turns only onto Military Road, N.W. Southbound traffic on 42nd Street at Military Road does not have turn restrictions.

Recent field observations have revealed that crossing movements, across 42nd Street, NW, influence the type and frequency of reported accidents at this intersection. Therefore, in the interest of public safety for pedestrians and motorists, an independent determination has been made by the DDOT/Transportation Operations Administration to restrict traffic along 42nd Street at Military Road, NW to right turns only on both approaches.
