4th Street and I Street, N.E.

Dear Ms Wirt,

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction.

Currently, the cross-type intersection of 4th Street and I Street, N.E., is controlled by a stop operation for I Street, N.W., so as to stop at 4th Street. The area residents and Advisory Neighborhood Commission 6C have requested that DDOT install a multi-way stop at this intersection. However, a recent field observation has revealed that the current control for this intersection is no longer adequate.

Therefore, in the interest of pedestrian and vehicle safety, an independent determination has been made by the DDOT/Transportation Operations Administration to install a multi-way stop control for 4th Street and I Street, so as to stop at both streets.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing, not later than thirty days (30), excluding weekends and holidays, after the date of this notice, with the District Department of Transportation, Transportation Operations Administration, 55 M Street, S.E., 6th Floor, Washington, D.C. 20003.
