**Re: Installation of All-way Stop Operations
Notice 13-88-TOA**

Dear Commissioner Jackson:

Pursuant to the “Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000” D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to each of the affected ANCs and the City Council Secretary for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction:

- Installation of All-way Stop Operation at 51st Street and A Street, S.E. and at 51st Street and Astor Place, S.E.


Currently, the intersection of 51st Street and A Street, S.E., is controlled by a stop operation on A Street and the intersection of 51st Street and Astor Place, S.E., is controlled by a stop operation on 51st Street. DDOT was contacted by Fire and Emergency Medical Services Department (FEMS) personnel concerning traffic and pedestrian safety at these intersections.

A recent traffic observation of the area revealed a need to stop all directions of traffic to improve the ability to safely navigate these intersections. Therefore, in the interest of pedestrian and vehicle safety, an independent determination has been made by the DDOT/Traffic Operations Administration to install a multi-way stop control on 51st Street and on A Street, S.E., so as to stop at both streets and on 51st Street and Astor Place, S.E., so as to stop at both streets.

All comments on this subject matter must be sent to Mr. James Cheeks of the District Department of Transportation at 55 M Street, S.E., 6th Floor, Washington, D.C. no later than thirty business days (30) after the date of this notice.
