**RE: ANC3D Resolution of no objection to bike infrastructure improvements in ANC 3D including bike lanes on New Mexico Avenue and a sidewalk extension on Nebraska Avenue and request for consideration of the proposed bike lane on New Mexico Avenue in the current Ward Circle Transportation Study**

Dear Mr. Bellamy:

At its properly-noticed public meeting on July 10, 2013, held at the American University, School of International Service, Founders Room, Washington, DC 20016, with a quorum present at all times, Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 3D voted 5-4-0 in resolution that the Advisory Neighborhood Commission 3D has no objection to bike infrastructure improvements in ANC 3D including bike lanes on New Mexico Avenue and a sidewalk extension on Nebraska Avenue, and requests, but does not require, that DDOT include in the current Ward Circle Transportation Study consideration on the proposed bike lane on New Mexico Avenue and to do so as rapidly as possible.

ANC3D heard from residents at a publicly noticed ANC3D meeting and held a special community meeting on the proposed bike lanes. Commissioners also participated in a site visit on New Mexico Avenue with DDOT representatives and interested neighbors.

Accordingly, ANC3D requests that the DC Department of Transportation consider this resolution and request, and asks that its resolution and request be given "Great Weight", D.C. Code 1 309.10(d)(3)(A).
