RE: Replacement bus shelters at MacArthur Boulevard and Cathedral Avenue NW and Massachusetts Avenue NW before Fordham Road NW

Dear Director Bellamy:

Advisory Neighborhood Commission 3D held its regular meeting on March 5th, 2014, at American University School of International Service with a quorum present at all times. Proper notice of the meeting was given on the ANC 3D website, the Northwest Current, and community listservs.

Mr. Anthony Foster, Citywide Transportation Planner at the District Department of Transportation, presented information on two existing "narrow" bus shelters which will be replaced with larger "non-ad" regular passenger bus shelter at two locations: 1) MacArthur Boulevard and Cathedral Avenue NW (by the Grand Lodge) and 2) Massachusetts Avenue NW before Fordham Road NW (by the Crate and Barrel).

The Commissioners voted 9-0-1 to support the replacement of the non-ad shelters at these two locations with the request that DDOT and WMATA explore options to include installation of digital capabilities to display bus arrival time and other important ridership information. The ANC3D Commissioners believe that DDOT should be make it possible for all new shelters being installed throughout the city to have current technology regardless of ridership numbers.
