**Re: Notification of Approval for Installation of Reserved Residential Parking Space for Disabled Resident

Dear Chairperson Higgins:

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction.

- *Notification of Approval for Installation of Reserved Residential Parking Space for Disabled Resident*

The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) has received a request from the resident at 516 Hamilton Street, NE for a reserved handicap residential on-street parking space. DDOT's initial decision was denial of the space based on the off-street parking. Since the resident received a letter from her doctor regarding her condition and how the exterior layout of the home affected on her condition. The front entrance would be best to access the home; after reviewing the property again and conferring with Ms. Tracy Coles, the new parking manager, DDOT has now reconsidered the decision and will approve the resident's request for the space in front of 516 Hamilton Street, NE.
