**Re: Permanent Change to Roadway Operation  
Notice 13-134-TOA**

Dear Mr. Norman:

Pursuant to the “Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000” D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to each of the affected ANCs and the City Council Secretary for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction:

- ***Permanent Change to the Roadway Operation at 1100-1200 block of Clifton Street, N.W***


*Currently, the 1100-1200 block of Clifton Street, N.W., is a one-way eastbound traffic pattern because of the construction of Cardozo High School by the Department of General Services. Prior to construction, this segment of Clifton Street was a two-way traffic pattern. The community as expressed to the Department of Transportation to leave the current one-way eastbound traffic pattern in place to provide better circulation and enhance pedestrian safety.*

*An on-site investigation has revealed that the “ONE-WAY” eastbound traffic pattern would have minimal impact on overall traffic circulation and enhance safety. Therefore, it is recommended that a “ONE-WAY” eastbound traffic pattern remain along the 1100-1200 bloc of Clifton Street, N.W., as referenced above*
