**Re: Installation of Embassy Diplomatic parking signs
NOI #14-32-TOA.**

Dear Ms. Smith:

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction.

The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) received a request from Embassy of Senegal at 2215 M ST, NW, to designate an area in front of their building to Embassy parking. Currently there is one metered parking space in front of their building. DC law DCMR Title 24 section 6.5 gives DDOT authority to have signs prohibiting parking along the curb in front of the building occupied by an embassy or legation of any foreign country, except for those vehicles bearing diplomatic motor vehicle identification tags. Therefore, our office has decided to remove the meter and install new signs to designate the space in front of the building for the Embassy of Senegal diplomatic parking only. The sign will read "No Parking 7AM-6:30PM Diplomatic Cars Only Embassy of Senegal Mon-Fri".
