Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction.

At the present time, the 1500 block of Galen Street, S.E., is a two-way traffic pattern between W Street and 15th Street, S.E. The DC Primary Care Association, with the support of the ANC 8A (Anthony Muhammed), have requested the installation of a partial one-way westbound traffic pattern for the 1500 block of Galen Street, S.E., from the parking lot driveway east of the Anacostia Health Center to 15th Street.

An on-site investigation has revealed that the "ONE-WAY" westbound traffic pattern would have minimal impact on overall traffic circulation and enhance safety. Therefore, it is recommended that a "ONE-WAY" traffic pattern be installed for the westbound Galen Street as referenced above. .
