**Re: Installation of No Parking Any Time Signs
Notice 14-34-TOA**

Dear Mr. Boisvert:

Pursuant to the “Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000” D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following modifications in your jurisdiction.

- ***Installation of No Parking Any Time signs at the intersection of Georgia Avenue and Newton Place, NW***

Currently, the intersection of Georgia Avenue and Newton Place, NW, is controlled by a stop operation on Newton Place. DDOT was contacted by the area residents concerning traffic safety of pedestrians at the intersection of Georgia Avenue and Newton Place, NW.

A recent traffic observation of the area revealed unsafe pedestrian crossing at this intersection. Therefore, in the interest of pedestrian safety, an independent determination has been made by the DDOT/ Traffic Operations Administration to install new crosswalk and pedestrian refuge at this intersection. These pedestrian improvements would require installation of No Parking Any Time signs, to prohibit vehicular parking in the vicinity of new pedestrian crosswalk, at this intersection..

All comments on this subject matter must be sent to Mr. James Cheeks of the District Department of Transportation at 55 M Street, S.E., 6th Floor, Washington, D.C. no later than thirty business days (30) after the date of this notice.
