**Re: Installation of ALL-WAY STOP signs (21<sup>st</sup> Street and I (Eye) Street, NE)**


Dear Ms. Henderson:

Pursuant to the “Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000” D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction.

Currently, the 4-way intersection of **21<sup>st</sup> and I (Eye) Streets, N.E.**, is controlled by a STOP sign on **I (eye) Street**. DDOT conducted a recent on-site study, the study revealed that due to the trees and curb roadways that line both sides of the streets, sight distance is limited and the existing controls are no longer adequate to control this intersection. Therefore, in the interest of pedestrians and vehicular traffic safety, the Transportation Operations Administration has made an independent determination to install STOP signs on **21<sup>st</sup> Street, N.E.**, as well as on **I (Eye) Street**.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing, no later than thirty (30) days after the date of this notice, with the District Department of Transportation (DDOT), Transportation Operations Administration, 55 M Street, SE, Washington, D.C. 20003.
