**Re: Installation of Residential Permit Parking  
Notice 14-05-TOA**

Dear Ms. Steptoe:

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following modifications in your jurisdiction.

Currently, the 1400 block of Irving Street, N.E. has unrestricted parking on both sides of the street. The residents have submitted a valid petition to install Residential Permit Parking in the 1400 Irving Street, NE. The times and days requested are 7:00 AM to 8:30 PM, Monday through Friday.

Traffic and parking surveys showed no impact to overall circulation or safety of pedestrians, bicyclists, or motorists. Therefore, we recommend that Residential Permit Parking be installed in the 1400 block of Irving Street, N.E. Both sides of the block will be signed Two Hour Parking, Resident Permit Parking, Zone 5, 7:00 AM to 8:30 PM, Monday through Friday.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing, no later than thirty (30) days after the date of this notice, with the District Department of Transportation (DDOT), Transportation Operations Administration, 55 M Street, SE, Washington, D.C. 20003.
