**Re: Installation of Rush Hour No Right Turn and Do Not Enter  
NOI #13-141-TOA**

Dear Ms. Muhammad:

Pursuant to the “Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000” D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to each of the affected ANCs and the City Council Secretary for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction:

- ***Installation of “No Right Turn 7:00 AM to 9:00 Am Monday through Friday and “Do Not Enter 7:00 AM to 9:30 AM Monday through Friday along Meade Street and Lane Avenue.***


Currently, Meade Street and Lane Place have no restrictions for traffic travelling southbound along the Kenilworth Avenue Service Roadway. The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) received a complaint from citizens in this community that traffic was using both Meade Street and Lane Place as a cut through around the cue for the traffic signal at the intersection of Kenilworth Avenue Service Roadway and Nannie Helen Burroughs Avenue in Northeast. The community is requesting restrictions along Meade Street and Lane Avenue to eliminate this cut through traffic.

DDOT conducted traffic and survey which revealed that both streets had a significant volume of cut through traffic due to the congestion along southbound Kenilworth Avenue (DC-295). Restricting access to Meade Street and Lane Place during the morning rush hour will have no significant impact to the overall circulation or safety of pedestrians, bicyclists, or motorists. Therefore, DDOT has made an independent decision to install “No Right Turn” and “Do Not Enter” signs between the hours of 7:00 AM through 9:30 AM, Monday through Friday at the intersections of Kenilworth Avenue and Meade Street and Kenilworth Avenue and Lane Place.

All comments on this subject matter must be sent to Mr. James Cheeks of the District Department of Transportation at 55 M Street, S.E., 6th Floor, Washington, D.C., no later than thirty business days (30) after the date of this notice.
