**Re: Installation of Traffic Control Signal – Ward 8  
Notice 13-93-TOA**

Dear Commissioner Carthens:

Pursuant to the “Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000” D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to each of the affected ANCs and the City Council Secretary for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction:

- Installation of a new Traffic Signal at the Intersection of Firth Sterling Avenue and Eaton Road, SE. Removal of STOP Sign Control on Eaton Road, SE Approaching Firth Sterling Avenue.


*Currently, Eaton Road, SE traffic is controlled by a STOP sign at its intersection with Firth Sterling Avenue. The opening of the new Department of Homeland Security Headquarters Building on the St. Elizabeth’s Hospital campus and the upcoming introduction of Street Car service to the Firth Sterling Avenue, SE corridor requires traffic signal control to manage and control vehicular and pedestrian traffic. The proposed new traffic signal will provide for the safe and efficient movement of vehicular and pedestrian traffic at this intersection, and it can be coordinated with adjacent traffic signals on the Firth Sterling Avenue, SE corridor to minimize disruptions to through traffic.*

*Therefore, in the interest of promoting the safe and efficient movement of vehicular and pedestrian traffic through and in the vicinity of this intersection, an independent determination has been made by the DDOT Transportation Services Administration to remove the existing STOP sign control on Eaton Road, SE at Firth Sterling Avenue, and to install and operate a traffic signal at the intersection of Firth Sterling Avenue and Eaton Road, SE.*
