**Re: Various Modifications to Parking and Traffic Requirements in Ward 6
(K Street, NE; Parker Street, NE; 2nd Street, NE; 3rd Street, NE; 4th Street, NE; and
5th Street, NE)
Notice # 13-39-TOA**

Dear Mr. Holmes:

Pursuant to the “Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000” – D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction:

- **The installation of “Local Traffic Only” (from 12am to 6am) signs on Parker Street**
- **The installation of signs prohibiting right turns from eastbound K Street onto 2nd Street, 3rd Street, 4th Street, and 5th Street from the hours of 12 am to 6 am**
- **The installation of signs restricting parking at all times to Ward 6 residents only on 2nd Street and 3rd Street between Parker Street and K Street**

Currently, Parker Street has no restrictions for traffic traveling along the roadway, and eastbound K Street has no right turning restrictions at 2nd Street, 3rd Street, 4th Street, or 5th Street. Additionally, 2nd Street and 3rd Street between Parker Street and K Street currently has residential permit parking related restrictions that limit parking to two hours between 7am and 8:30pm, Monday through Friday – except for Zone 6 permit holders (who are exempt from these restrictions). In an effort to assist the Metropolitan Police Department (MPD) in deterring illicit activity in the area created by circling traffic and parking/idling of vehicles, the District


Department of Transportation will make three changes to traffic/parking in this vicinity. The first change will be the installation of "Local Traffic Only" signs on Parker Street, which will also include additional verbiage denoting the times of 12am to 6am. The second change will be the installation of right turn restriction signs on K Street that would prohibit right turns onto 2nd Street, 3rd Street, 4th Street, and 5th Street. Finally, the current residential permit parking signs on 2nd Street and 3rd Street between K Street and Parker Street will be replaced with signage restricting parking at all times to Ward 6 residents only.
