**Re: Installation of a New Traffic Signal at the Intersection of Maine Avenue and I-395 Ramp Terminal, S.W. NOI 19-05-TESD**

Dear Chairperson Fast:

Pursuant to the “Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000” D. C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following modifications in your jurisdiction.

- ***Installation of a New Traffic Signal at the Intersection of Maine Avenue and I-395 Ramp Terminal S.W. (See attachment A)***

Currently, the intersection is controlled by a YIELD sign on Maine Avenue, S.W. A recent traffic engineering study has concluded that placement of a new traffic signal at Maine Avenue and I-395 Ramp Terminal S.W. will improve the overall traffic operation in and around this intersection.

Therefore, in the interest of promoting the safe and efficient movement of vehicular and pedestrian traffic through and in the vicinity of this intersection, an independent determination has been made by the DDOT Traffic Engineering and Signals Division to remove the existing YIELD sign control on all approaches of the intersection and to install and operate a new traffic signal system at the intersection of Maine Avenue and I-395 Ramp Terminal, S.W.

We are providing a total of 30 business days for public comment. All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing by Tuesday, March 5, 2019 (thirty business days after the date of this notice), with the District Department of Transportation, Project Delivery Administration at 55 M Street, SE, Washington, D.C. 20003.
