Re: Notification of Approval for Reserved Residential Parking Space for Disabled Resident

Dear Mr. Toliver:

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following modifications in your jurisdiction.

DDOT received a request from a resident who resides at **1378 Rittenhouse Street, N.W.** The resident requested a Reserved Handicap on-street Permit Parking space to be placed in front of their home. DDOT conducted an on-site investigation and found that the resident meets all of the requirements to have a Reserved Handicap on-street Permit Parking space.

Therefore, our office has approved the said resident to have a Reserved Handicap on-street Permit Parking space with the shortest possible circulation route and least amount of stairs to the residence.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing, not later than thirty days (30) after the date of this notice, with the District Department of Transportation, Transportation Operations Administration, 55 M Street, S.E.
