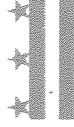

Dear Ms. Seegarss:

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction.

Currently, the "1 stop sign" - intersection of 15<sup>th</sup> street and Bruce Place, S.E. is controlled by a Stop sign on 15<sup>th</sup> Street this intersection is a crossing point for parents and children traveling to and from J.H. Johnson JHS on Bruce Place SE.

Since it is DDOT's policy to provide maximum protection for pedestrian and motorists, additional STOP signs should be installed on Bruce Place SE. Therefore, in the interest of pedestrian and vehicular traffic safety, an independent determination has been made by the Infrastructure Project Management Administration to install additional Stop signs making this intersection an All-Way Stop sign control.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing, not later than thirty days (30) after the date of this notice, with the District Department of Transportation, Infrastructure Project Management Administration, 64 New York Ave N.W., 1st Floor, Washington, D.C. 20002.
