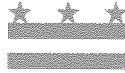

**Re: Installation of ALL-WAY STOP signs
Notice # 11-15 IPMA
45th & Brandywine Streets, N.W.**

Dear Ms. Bairstow:

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction.

Currently, the 4-way intersection of **45th & Brandywine Streets, N.W.**, is controlled by a STOP sign on 45th Street. A recent on-site study has revealed that due to cut-through traffics, limited site distance and high volume of pedestrians and the existing controls are no longer adequate to control this intersection. Therefore, in the interest of pedestrian and vehicular traffic safety, the Infrastructure Project Management Administration has made a determination to install STOP signs on **Brandywine Street, N.W.**, as well as on **45th Street**.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing, not later than thirty days (30) after the date of this notice, with the District Department of Transportation, Infrastructure Project Management Administration, **55 M Street, S.E., 4st Floor, Washington, D.C. 20003**.


