Dear Mr. Quirk:

Pursuant to the “Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000” D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction.

Currently, the **Crittenden Street**, eastbound and westbound and **Illinois Avenue** northbound and southbound approaches to **Sherman Circle, N.W.** is controlled by a “Yield to Traffic in Circle” signs. A recent on-site study has revealed that due to the curb roadways; significant vehicles conflicts; excessive traffic speeds, especially at the circle’s entries and exits; and both sides of both streets; and sight distance to the circle is limited. The existing controls are no longer adequate for safety of the pedestrians within the crosswalks in the circle to control these four legs. Therefore, in the interest of pedestrians and vehicular traffic safety, the Infrastructure Project Management Administration has made a determination to install STOP signs on **Crittenden Street, N.E.**, and **Illinois Avenue, N.E. at Sherman Circle.**

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing, not later than thirty days (30) after the date of this notice, with the District Department of Transportation, Infrastructure Project Management Administration, 55 M Street, S.E., 5th Floor, Washington, D.C. 20003.
