Dear Ms. Grant:

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction.

Currently, the 4-way intersection of **12th and Irving Streets, N.E.**, is controlled by a STOP sign on Irving Street. A recent on-site study has revealed that due to the trees and curb roadways that lines both sides of both streets sight distance is limited and the existing controls are no longer adequate to control this intersection. Therefore, in the interest of pedestrian and vehicular traffic safety, the Infrastructure Project Management Administration has made a determination to install STOP signs on **12th Street, N.E.**, as well as on **Irving Street**.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing, not later than thirty days (30) after the date of this notice, with the District Department of Transportation, Infrastructure Project Management Administration, 55 M Street, S.E. Washington, D.C. 20003.
