Dear Ms. Smith:

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction.

At present the intersection of River Road and 43<sup>rd</sup> Street NW, commuters traveling southeast on River Road are making a right turn onto 43<sup>rd</sup> Street as a cut-through to avoid the traffic signal at 42<sup>nd</sup> Street and River Road. To avoid cut-through traffic and restore 43<sup>rd</sup> Street to its attended function as a local street and enhance safety for neighbor pedestrians, and motorists, the Infrastructure Project Management Administration (IPMA) has made a determination to install a No Right Turn 6:00am to 9:30am Monday-Friday sign.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing, not later than thirty days (30) after the date of this notice, with the District Department of Transportation, Infrastructure Project Management Administration, 55 MM Street, SE; Washington, D.C. 20003.
