Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction.

Currently, the 2700 block of Martin Luther King Avenue, SE has a morning (7am-9:30am) and evening (4pm-6:30pm) parking restriction. A recent on-site study has revealed that due to the existing ongoing construction traffic and the high volume of vehicular traffic introduced to that area, a "No Parking Anytime" restriction would discourage drivers from parking between the rush hour restricted times. This change will help to maintain open travel lanes at all times.
