Dear Chairperson Vaughn:

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction.

Our office has received a request from Shervonne B. Walker of 524 Crittenden Street NW, for Reserved Residential Parking Space for Disabled Resident for on-street parking space. The residence has off-street parking driveway or garage which does meet the American with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1998, being at least 90 inches wide but the route to the building or facility entrance does not meet, because there are more stairs in the back of the residence than the front.

Therefore, our office has decided to allow the said resident to have a reserved on-street parking space with the shortest possible circulation route and least amount of stairs to the residence.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing, not later than thirty days (30) after the date of this notice, with the District Department of Transportation, Transportation Operations Administration, 55 M Street, S.E.; Washington, D.C. 20003
