**Re: Installation of All-Way Stop Signs:
Notice# 12-33-IPMA**

Dear Chairperson Bender:

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction.

At the present time, the intersection of Belt Road and Fessenden Street N.W.; is controlled by "Stop" signs on Belt Road. A recent field observation has revealed that due to a tree brush and a fence on the northeast and northwest corners of this intersection, visibility is limited. To enhance safety for pedestrians and motorists alike, the Transportation Operations Administration has made an independent determination to install "Stop" signs on Fessenden Street, N.W., as well as on Belt Road.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing, not later than thirty days (30) after the date of this notice, with the District Department of Transportation, Transportation Operations Administration, 55 M Street SE, Washington, DC 20003.
