**Re: Installation of All-Way STOP signs
Notice # 12-34 IPMA**

Dear Mr. Graber:

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction.

Currently, the intersection of 4th Street and I Street, S.E. is controlled by a Stop sign on I Street; this intersection is a crossing point for Pedestrians. Motorist are using this roadway to access new developments around the M street corridor and the installation of All-Way Stop signs would provide a break in traffic and bring some much needed control to this roadway. This installation would also make it safer for motorists and pedestrians alike.

Since it is DDOT's policy to provide maximum protection for pedestrian and motorists, additional STOP signs should be installed on 4th street SE. Therefore, in the interest of pedestrian and vehicular traffic safety, an independent determination has been made by the Transportation Operations Administration to install additional Stop signs making this intersection a Multi-Way Stop sign control.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing, not later than thirty days (30) after the date of this notice, with the District Department of Transportation, Transportation Operations Administration, 55 M Street SE 4th Floor Washington D.C. 20003.
