Re: Installation of Enhanced Residential Permit Parking


Pursuant to the “Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000” D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following modifications in your jurisdiction.

Currently, Residential Permit Parking (RPP) exists in the 100 block of Thomas Street, N.E., which provides restrictions on parking between the hours of 7:00 AM to 8:30 PM, Monday through Friday. The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) received a valid petition from the residents of this block requesting that the current RPP be converted to Resident Only Parking between the hours of 7:00 AM to Midnight, Monday through Sunday.

DDOT conducted a traffic and parking survey which revealed no impact to the overall circulation or safety of pedestrians, bicyclists, or motorists. Therefore, DDOT has made an independent decision to install Enhanced Residential Permit Parking in the 100 block of Thomas Street, NE. On the north side of the block signs will read “Resident Only Zone 5, 7:00 AM to Midnight, Monday through Sunday.” The signs on the south side of the block will read “Two Hour Parking Zone 5, 7:00 to Midnight, Monday-Sunday.”

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing no later than thirty (30) days after the date of this notice with the District Department of Transportation (DDOT), Transportation Operations Administration, 55 M Street, SE, Washington, D.C. 20003.
