Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction.

Currently, the 1700 block of Florida Avenue, N.W. has unrestricted parking on the north side. A recent request from Planet Pet to install parking meters was received on September 5, 2013. DDOT has agreed that this change will benefit their customers and the existing storage company at # 1701. Therefore, the District Department of Transportation proposes to implement "One and Two Hour Parking, 7:00am – 6:30pm, Monday through Saturday to better accommodate the businesses.
