
Dear Mr. Simpson:

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction.

District Department Transportation (DDOT) has completed a field investigation of 2300 Champlain Street NW, and found that the commercial property at 2390 is currently vacant. DDOT will have the parking meters adjacent to 2390 removed and Resident-Only Parking signs will be installed. DDOT does not install residential parking adjacent to commercial property, so if the building at 2390 is redeveloped for commercial uses we will remove the residential parking, and reinstall the parking meters.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing, not later than thirty days (30) after the date of this notice, with the District Department of Transportation (DDOT), Transportation Operations Administration, **55 M Street, S.E., 5th Floor, Washington, D.C. 20003**.
