**Re: Installation of Additional Sunday Parking
Notice 13-40-TOA**

Dear Mr. Raymond:

Pursuant to the “Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000” D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to each of the affected ANCs and the City Council Secretary for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction:

- Installation of Additional Sunday Parking


Currently, Enhanced Residential Parking regulations designed to protect neighborhood parking has affected parking for church parishioners located in communities represented by Advisory Neighborhood 2F. In an effort to provide more parking opportunities, the District Department of Transportation will make No Parking areas available on Sundays from 7:00 AM to 2:00 PM for the following limits in N.W.: P Street to the north, M Street to the south, 11th Street to the east, and 13th Street to the west.

A safety evaluation conducted at each location show no impact to overall circulation or safety of pedestrians, bicyclists, or motorists. The new signing will generate approximately 32 additional parking spaces for use by all users. Therefore, we recommend that designated No Parking areas be made available for parking from 7:00 AM to 2:00 PM Sundays for the boundary of P Street to the north, M Street to the south, 11th Street to the east, and 13th Street, N.W. in Ward 2.
