Re: Conversion to two-way for F Street between Columbus Circle and 2nd Street, NE


Pursuant to the “Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000” D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction:

The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) received a request to convert the 100 Block of F Street, NE from a one-way to a two-way. This block is located between Columbus Circle and 2nd Street, NE. DDOT concluded that converting this block from one-way to two-way would have the following benefits:

1. Alleviate the traffic congestion adjacent to Union Station, (2nd Street and Massachusetts Avenue) specifically in the morning hours as vehicles traveling to one of the three parking garages that is located in the 100 block of F Street. By changing the traffic pattern from a one way to a two ways it will allow motorist to not be forced to loop around Columbus Circle to get to the garages.
2. Reduce the number of vehicles traveling across the two high-visibility crosswalks located along Columbus Circle, currently this is the only way to get to the parking garages along the 100 block of F Street, NE. This change will help make the two crosswalks safer for Pedestrains and will provide motorist with a shorter commute to the parking garages.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing, no later than thirty (30) days after the date of this notice, with the District Department of Transportation (DDOT), Transportation Operations Administration , 55 M Street, SE, Washington, D.C. 20003.
