**Re: Installation of Reserved Handicap on-street Permit Parking Space for Disabled Resident with a driveway or garage that is American Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1998 compliant.**

Dear Chairperson Vaughn:

Pursuant to the “Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000” D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction.

DDOT received a request from the resident who resides at **249 Rock Creek Church Road, NW**. The resident requested a reserved handicap on-street permit parking space to be placed in front of their home. DDOT conducted an on-site investigation and found that the mentioned residence has off-street parking, a driveway or garage which does meet the American with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1998, being at least 90 inches wide but due to too many stairs and the route to the entrance it would be safer for the resident to enter from the front of the property.

Therefore, our office has decided to allow the said resident to have a reserved handicap on-street permit parking space with the shortest possible circulation route and least amount of stairs to the residence.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing, not later than thirty days (30) after the date of this notice, with the District Department of Transportation, Transportation Operations Administration, 55 M Street, S.E.
