Dear Ms. Smith,

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following modification in your jurisdiction.

The intersection of 20th Street at Jackson Street, NE currently operates as a stop-controlled intersection with stop sign control on Jackson Street. However, the DDOT/Office of the Director received a request to install a 4-way stop operation to control this intersection. In the interest of pedestrian and vehicle safety, an independent determination has been made by the DDOT/Transportation Operations Administration (TOA) to install a 4-way stop operation on 20th Street intersection at Jackson Street, NE to provide stop conditions on both streets. DDOT will also install "No Parking Any Time" signs on 20th Street and Jackson Street to restrict on-street parking within 25 feet of the 4-way stop signs.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing, not later than thirty days (30), excluding weekends and holidays, after the date of this notice, with the District Department of Transportation, Transportation Operations Administration, 55 M Street, SE, 4th Floor, Washington, DC 20003
