Re: Installation of "Resident Only" Residential Permit Parking


Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to provide written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following modifications in your jurisdiction.

Currently, the 300 block of T Street, N.W. has unrestricted parking on both sides of the street. DDOT received a valid petition from the residents of this block to install Residential Permit Parking (RPP), Zone 5, between the hours of 7:00 AM to 8:30 PM, Monday through Friday.

DDOT conducted a traffic and parking survey, which revealed no impact to overall circulation or safety of pedestrians, bicyclists, or motorists. Therefore, DDOT has made an independent decision to install parking signs for RPP, Zone 5, between the hours of 7:00 AM to 8:30 PM, Monday through Friday, in the 300 block of T Street, N.W.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing, no later than thirty (30) days after the date of this notice, with the District Department of Transportation (DDOT), Transportation Operations Administration (TOA), 55 M Street, SE, Washington, D.C. 20003.
