**Re: Notification for the Installation of Bicycle Lanes on New Mexico Avenue.**

**Notice# 13-84-PPSA**

Dear Commissioner Pagano,

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give written notice of our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction:

**Installation of bicycle lanes on New Mexico Avenue, NW between Nebraska Avenue and 42<sup>nd</sup> Street, and Tunlaw Road NW between 42<sup>nd</sup> Street and 39<sup>th</sup> Street.**

The combination of bicycle lanes and shared travel lanes *will not affect existing automobile travel and parking lanes*. ANC 3D passed a resolution on July 23, 2013 of no objection to bicycle infrastructure improvements, including bike lanes on New Mexico Avenue, NW.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing, not later than thirty days (30) after the date of this notice, with the District Department of Transportation.
