Re: Notification of Approval for Installation of Reserved Residential Parking Space for Disabled Resident.


Dear Mr. Cohen:

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction.

The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) has received a request from Ms. Bernice T. Scully of 2021 Tunlaw Road, NW for a reserved handicap residential on-street parking space. According to 54 DCR 903 (February 2, 2007) section 2710.1 through 2710.3 the Director of DDOT may reserve one (1) on-street parking space for any District resident who apply in writing who qualifies under section 2710.1 (a) through (e). Therefore, DDOT has approved said resident to have a reserved on-street parking space with the shortest possible circulation route.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing, no later than thirty (30) days after the date of this notice, with the District Department of Transportation (DDOT), Transportation Operations Administration, 55 M Street, SE, Washington, D.C. 20003.
