**Re: Enhanced Residential Parking - Notice 13-26-TOA**

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following modifications in your jurisdiction.

Currently, the unit block of R Street, N.W. has Residential Permit Parking between North Capitol Street and 1st Street, N.W. The hours of operation for this parking are 7:00 AM to 8:30 PM Monday through Friday. A valid petition has been received from the residents of the unit block of R Street to convert the existing Residential Permit Parking to Enhanced Residential Permit Parking. This will have the effect of installing Resident Only Parking, Zone 6 from 7:00 AM to Midnight Monday through Sunday on the west side of the block and Two Hour Parking from 7:00 AM to Midnight, Monday through Sunday, Zone 6 Exempted.

An on-site investigation has revealed that the proposed change would have minimal impact on traffic circulation or existing parking inventory. Therefore, we recommend that the unit block of R Street, N.W., be converted to Enhanced Residential Parking 7:00 AM to Midnight Resident Only Monday through Sunday on the west side and 7:00 AM to Midnight Two Hour Parking Zone 6 Exempted Monday through Sunday on the east side.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing, not later than thirty days (30) after the date of this notice with the District Department of Transportation, Traffic Operations Administration, 55 M Street S.E., 6th Floor, Washington, D.C. 20003.
