**ANC 3C Resolution 2013-026**  
Regarding Nighttime Utility Work on Wisconsin Avenue, NW

WHEREAS, DDOT has approved a Traffic Control Plan related to the Cathedral Commons Project on the 3300 and 3400 blocks of Wisconsin Avenue NW, and

WHEREAS, that Traffic Control Plan addresses certain utility work to be performed on Wisconsin Avenue NW and the hours during which that utility work may be performed, and

WHEREAS, that utility work will require heavy excavation of the roadway including the use of jack hammers, hoe rams, street saw cutting, light towers, constant machinery movement, dump trucks and other construction-related apparatuses and vehicles that will generate a substantial amount of noise and disturbance, and

WHEREAS, that utility work is expected to take approximately nine to twelve weeks to complete, and

WHEREAS, DDOT has required this utility work take place exclusively during the night and has effectively prohibited the developer and construction partner from performing this work during the day, and

WHEREAS, the east side of Wisconsin Avenue NW facing the site where the utility work is to occur is comprised entirely of single-family and mid-rise residences, and

WHEREAS, to the west of the site is another mid-rise residential building on Idaho Avenue NW, which currently has an unobstructed and open space between itself and Wisconsin Avenue NW due to the demolition of the buildings on that block, and

WHEREAS, the noise from the utility work will create a substantial disruption to the residents who live in those buildings, interfering with their quiet enjoyment of their homes and severely impeding their ability to sleep at night, and

WHEREAS, the work is expected to require the closure of only two lanes of traffic, and

WHEREAS, the same work could be performed during the day between 9:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m., thereby eliminating the impact on rush-hour traffic.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 3C objects to the requirement imposed by DDOT that this utility work be performed solely at night when residents are trying to sleep, and

BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 3C requests DDOT revise or amend the Traffic Control Plan to remove the stipulation that all work be performed at night and instead, allow the work to be performed during the hours that maximize safety and minimize disruption and noise, as coordinated with the Cathedral Commons Construction Liaison Committee, and

BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 3C requests DDOT require the developer to secure any metal plates placed over excavated portions of the road during non-work hours such that the noise generated by traffic passing over the plates is minimized, and

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chair and commissioners representing SMDs 05, 06, 07 and 09 are authorized to represent ANC 3C on this matter.
