Re: Notification of Approval for Reserved Residential Permit Parking Space for Disabled Resident


Dear Mr. Flahaven:

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following modifications in your jurisdiction.

The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) received a request from Mr. Roy L. Robinson of 722 4th Street, SE for Reserved Handicap on-street parking. According to 54 DCR 903 (February 2, 2007), section 2710.1 through 2710.3, the Director of DDOT may reserve one (1) on-street parking space for any District resident who applies in writing for a reserved space and who qualifies under section 2710.1 (a) through (e). DDOT conducted a parking survey and reviewed all of the documents Mr. Robinson submitted; as a result of our survey we found that the said resident meets all of the qualifications for approval. Therefore, DDOT has approved Mr. Robinson to have a Reserved Handicap on-street parking permit for a space with the shortest possible circulation route.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing, not later than thirty days (30) after the date of this notice, with the District Department of Transportation, Transportation Operations Administration, 55 M Street, N.W.
