Re: Installation of New High intensity Activated Crosswalk (HAWK) Signals at the Intersection of South Dakota Avenue and Ingraham Street, N.E. NOI 19-63-TESD

Dear Chairperson:

Pursuant to the “Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000” D. C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following modifications in your jurisdiction.

- ***Installation of a New HAWK Signal at the Intersection of South Dakota Avenue and Ingraham Street, N.E.***

An independent determination has been made by the DDOT/Traffic Engineering and Signals Division to install and operate a High intensity Activated Crosswalk (HAWK) signal at the intersection of South Dakota Avenue and Ingraham Street, N.E. HAWK signal control can provide for the safe and efficient movement of vehicular and pedestrian traffic operating through and in the immediate vicinity of this intersection. The proposed new HAWK signal on South Dakota Avenue and Ingraham Street, N.E. will be timed to operate in harmony with adjacent traffic signals on the South Dakota Avenue corridor to minimize disruptions to through traffic. Work also includes reconstruction of ADA ramps and streetlights upgrade.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing by Friday, May 3, 2019 (thirty business days after the date of this notice), with the District Department of Transportation (DDOT), Traffic Engineering and Signals Division at 55 M Street, SE, Washington, D.C. 20003.
