**Re: Installation of Traffic Control Signal – Ward 8
Notice 13-101-TOA**

Dear Commissioner Stith:

Pursuant to the “Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000” D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to each of the affected ANCs and the City Council Secretary for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction:

- Installation of a New Traffic Signal at the Intersection of South Capitol Street and the Street Car Maintenance Facility.


Currently, DDOT is constructing a Maintenance Facility on South Capitol Street south of Firth Sterling Avenue, SE at the terminus of the Anacostia Street Car Line. A new traffic signal is to be installed at the entrance of this facility to control traffic on South Capitol Street while Street Cars maneuver in and out of the facility. DDOT has determined that the introduction of Street Car traffic crossing South Capitol Street introduces a hazard with the potential to compromise vehicular and pedestrian safety in the South Capitol Street corridor unless traffic signal control is provided. The proposed new traffic signal will provide for the safe and efficient movement of vehicular and pedestrian traffic at this intersection, and it can be coordinated with adjacent traffic signals on the South Capitol Street Corridor to minimize disruptions to through traffic.

Therefore, in the interest in promoting the safe and efficient movement of vehicular traffic through and in the vicinity of this intersection, an independent determination has been made by the DDOT Transportation Services Administration to install and operate a new traffic signal at the intersection of South Capitol Street and the Street Car Maintenance Facility.
