Re: VPP, Visitor Parking Permits, deadline for comments September 9, 2013

Dear Mr. Marcou:

I am writing in my capacity as ANC 6C02 commissioner.

ANC 6C received a notification from your office, dated August 9, 2013, asking for comments on the proposal to distribute VPPs to DC residents. The letter stated that comments were to be received within 30 days, by September 9.

I respectfully would like to point out that most ANCs, including ANC 6C, are in recess during the month of August. The Council takes a recess during this month, and agencies such as the Zoning Commission and the Board of Zoning Adjustment do not schedule hearings because they know much of the city closes down in August. Thus the request for receipt of ANC comments on distribution of VPPs is poorly timed if your office expects to hear from the communities the ANCs represent.

ANC 6C holds its next regularly scheduled monthly meeting on September 12. We have planned a community discussion of VPPs at that time. (We have not had a regularly scheduled monthly meeting with the public present since July 10.) If you could hold the record open until September 13, ANC 6C will send you comments on the VPP proposal.
